



Falcon GT Club Memories:
Greg Archer

My original club number was number 9, (Well not any more, it's about 186 after a 20 year break) so I guess I go back a while. My time slides back over 25 years to the days of Stuart and Belinda being President and Secretary, during those heady days Valla had not long been going and the GT Nationals were to be held at Bathurst.

I did hold the position of President, and various other committee positions, but by far the most intense job was the one of news letter editor, it was the days before computers so it was drama for 2 weeks of each month just putting it together. It was crazy; I still have the originals just to remind me of how it was before the days of Microsoft Windows. Many a time we had the newsletter back in bulk from the printer and then spent a long night on Joe and Debbie's lounge room floor collating, stapling and enveloping. The satisfaction in those days was knowing that the members loved receiving the newsletter in the mail. Thank god the Postie can bring something other than bills every now and again.

Going back to the earlier days I do recall the occasional dud GT, you know the type; a retired XY or XW taxi tarted up to be an original GT. Luckily we had, amongst others, Stuart and Brett who could spot a faker at 200 yards (they were more than sharp at spotting fake GT's as well).

Remembering all of this, Robin and I have been married for 22 years, which may surprise a few old members that maybe thinking back on those times.

During 1991 both Robin and I had the great pleasure of assisting Andrew Quinn and Tony Davis getting together a documented history of the Falcon GT with the assistance of many club member cars. I am sure the book is still available: Spotlight on Ford Falcon GT & GT-HO by Andrew Quinn: Marque publications. Also around the same time many of our club cars were featured in Modern Motor Magazine, Satisfying to us was that much of the text was straight out of the club newsletter, especially the article on the XT's, so I guess we must have been getting a few of the facts right. Fred Gibson even made contact just to let us know the only reason his XT lost Bathurst to the Monaros was that he had a stone through the radiator.

10 years ago we both decided to retire and sell up everything in Sydney including our GT's and moved to Tallwoods just north of Forster Tuncurry. We purchased a Honda ST 1100 Motor Cycle and toured Australia. Only fell off once, that was at 160kph outside Woomera Rocket Range. Remarkably we survived that 'little' incident after hurtling off the road for some distance then landing against a rock in the bull dust. Rob was really upset as she had red dust on her jeans. "My God do you realise what just happened" "Well yes I do but you must understand these jeans were brand new!"

The Red Pepper XB 4 door had been sold to our son Duane during earlier divorce proceedings. That was about 24 years ago and our beautiful old White XT lingered on till about 2005 when it was sold and is now hidden away on Parramatta Road somewhere. Some of you old guys will remember its plates as GUN.302 (Wonder who has those plates now?) The Red Pepper XB is now part of the Newcastle GT group I believe, and looks as good as it ever did - maybe we will get to see it some day.

Robin's Polar White XB 4 door was stolen from the house at Doonside never to be seen again. Frankly that was the final straw re owning a GT, but alas, it was still flowing through the blood and boy did I like the look and sound of those BA GT's.

The ultimatum, you want another GT the bike must go, well OK that didn't take long and now a beautiful manual Venom Red BA GT slumbers away in the garage.

Also during this revitalisation of our GT interests our son David with the help of Andrew were breathing new life into the "Kwik as Air" XB GT. Man what a colour and stunning restoration, we could only be inspired watching that beautiful car take shape.

Three years ago an application to re join the GT club went in after 20 long years, and a visit to Valla came not long after, just to see the look on Oliver and Stacey's face when we walked in to register was worth all the effort. For us it was a home coming, fantastic to see all the old faces and listen to the same old Peter W's jokes all over again. No worries Peter, Rob still reckons that they are just as good as the first time she heard them.

That year sitting there with a cold beer in the Valla sunshine watching the GT's going round and round I remembered the old days when things weren't so politically correct and controlled. Back then the smell of burnt rubber filled the air as great plumes of smoke filtered skyward to the cheers of the gathered multitude. The GT's were much younger and not as valuable then, so you know, what's wrong with a burnout or two or three or maybe all afternoon! I guess the world wasn't quite so precious back then.

We read in the Newsletter that Martin is President and we are going back to the RSL Car Park this year, it's all going full circle.

But burnouts: Don't even think about it!
It's not what we do anymore.
Just have a great time anyway.


FGTOCNSW Bathurst Weekend run - August 29th and 30th 2015

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT AUGUST 2015

Hello again fellow GT enthusiasts.

Well the last month has been pretty full on for the committee and I feel that we got a good number of things achieved. Without going into too much detail – you can read about the engaging discussions we have had at the meetings in the minutes, I am very pleased with the response from our members about the venue change for our monthly meetings.

From September 14, we will be at the Windsor Room in the Northmead Bowling Club. There is some information and photos on our website. You can also look at the bowling club's (NBC) website <http://nbcsportsclub.com.au/> . They have a great cafe/grill with a menu that will suit everyone.

There is plenty of seating, and even a 100 seat balcony overlooking the greens which would be great during summer for a meal and a beer before the meeting. Our treasurer Ken, has now paid for all meetings till the end of 2016 ensuring we have secured the Windsor function room. The Windsor room itself has a 200 seat capacity, and has a stage with a pull down screen and a roof mounted projector which we can utilise for playing racing videos or doing presentations etc.

If you have not already heard, racing legend Colin Bond will be our special guest for our November meeting, and wouldn't it be good if we had that function room filled to hear him speak. To encourage attendance, we will also be having a badge draw for attendees only with a great autographed prize.

I would like to give Rex S a special thanks for all his help in reviewing the success of the conditional registration scheme in our club. Rex and I discussed member participation and have been through the runs and meeting books and cross checked against our member database. While I have not looked at every run through the history available, a pattern quickly emerged showing that the most active percentage of members had a vehicle on CRS.

If we can encourage some of our members who have an unregistered GT, to put their car on the CRS with our club, it can only be a positive step forward. In order to achieve this, one of the initiatives is to extend the number of secondary club runs available to members. This will not only provide more options and make the scheme more attractive, but will also ensure the legal use of CRS vehicles attending car events, by having the events listed, rather than by providing a special dispensation. We also need to look at secondary runs for country members, again from a legal stand point. So country members, if there is an event in your local area, let us know and we can review it and promote it on our events page.

These secondary runs, car shows like Rattle 'n' Hum in July, the V8 Supercars this month, and Sunday Cars and Doughnuts, are a great place to promote our club to the public, potentially attract new members and even persuade some existing members to bring their car out. To increase the FUN factor, as well as maximise the promotion of our club, why not get together with some club mates, so you can cruise to and from these events, and park your cars together displaying the club windscreen banner. If you don't have a banner, contact the committee and we can sort it out.

So, how do you contact members when its forecast to be a nice day on Sunday and you want to go for a cruise to one of the secondary runs? The ideal tool for this is a forum, so we have created one for our club. This will ensure only club members have access to the forum, and there is no confusion as to who is who. There are a few sub forums already in place for you to look at and add your comments and photos. The forum is in its infancy, so we welcome any suggestions or requests for further sub forums.

Inside "Club Runs and Events" you will find "Secondary Club Events" – this is the area where you can create a topic for a secondary run you plan on attending, so that others can join you, and you can make arrangements for time and meeting etc. I suggest you give these topics a title which is the run name eg. Sunday Breakfast Kellyville September 6.


