## From The President

Hello once again to all members,  
I hope that everyone is healthy and safe during, well let's face it, a year to forget for many reasons.

Since the club's last correspondence, there have been no new covid-19 mass gathering restrictions, or the lifting of any existing restrictions. The committee remains upbeat that life will return to normal before the year's end, and we are happy to add events where possible to make up for some lost time.

Firstly, on behalf of the committee, I wish to thank everyone for understanding the difficulty of having to postpone or cancel runs, especially at the moment when social isolation for many people is becoming increasingly difficult to deal with. To my surprise I have not had one member question, nor complain about the committee's decisions, since COVID first struck way back in March. Even though 2020 is the year to forget, I guarantee that we will be remembering 2020 for years to come, hopefully having a laugh when reflecting on how crazy things were during the pandemic, with toilet paper being a hot commodity for many weeks!

I only recently called for a committee meeting on Monday 24/8/20, to discuss: the planned events for the rest of the year; club

meetings for the remainder of 2020; the current COVID-19 restrictions and also the Gold Coast/Bathurst GT Nationals.

With regard to our upcoming events/runs, there is no exciting news on that front as the committee was unanimous in its decision to cancel all events for September, due to the current covid-19 restrictions. As we have previously mentioned in our covid-19 updates, our club simply cannot conduct a mass gathering of 20 people or more (*every event that we hold is well over 20 people*), and if we choose to ignore these restrictions, the club and committee are liable and face significant fines. The committee is well aware of other clubs' activities at present and we simply do not want to be *'that club'* who made the 6pm news. It is just not worth the risk and quite frankly not worth the embarrassment, if caught flaunting the rules.

The committee tried it's best to conduct a club meeting at Supercheap Auto Penrith on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July, utilizing the large capacity of the store to hold a meeting, well within the covid guidelines. But ultimately a decision was made by Supercheap Auto's senior management to cancel the event, no less than 24hrs before the event. We were close, but that is the way it goes sometimes.

As a result of this meeting being cancelled, the club is going to purchase a cheap mobile phone on a prepaid plan, in which it will be used to send text messages to the entire membership to make members aware of sudden changes to events. This mobile can also be used as a friendly reminder about membership renewals as well. This will be of benefit to all members and vastly improve communication to members, especially when time is against us on some occasions.

At present our next planned club event is the Burger Point evening run on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> October. The committee will reassess if the run can go ahead about a week prior, assessing what restrictions are still in place leading up to this event. If this event does not go ahead, the committee will endeavor to make all members aware, using all means possible.

On the club meetings front, again there is no good news there either. Northmead Bowling Club informed the committee in early August that there will be no functions for the rest of 2020 and therefore our club will not be conducting any further club meetings in 2020. The committee did call numerous other venues to try and conduct a meeting, but all venues have made similar decisions to cancel all bookings for 2020. If restrictions do lift before the year's end, the

committee will call a club meeting at the earliest convenience.

Many members are now aware that the 19<sup>th</sup> Falcon GT Nationals scheduled to be held on the Gold Coast over Easter has now been cancelled due to covid. Back in May the idea was floated of postponing this event by 12 months by the NAFGTC, which would then in turn push back all other GT Nationals by 12 months as well. This proposal will need to be agreed and voted on by all of the NAFGTC before committing to such decision. The NAFGTC floated this proposal to our committee and we all agreed in principle with this decision. As soon as any decision is made of the future of the 19<sup>th</sup> GT Nationals, we will get that out to the membership ASAP.

The annual Valla Beach weekend is another victim of covid, with the weekend being cancelled all together. Initially the weekend was going to happen without the formalities of the typical Valla weekend, but the committee has learned that the decision to cancel the entire weekend came after the Valla Beach Resort made a decision that no major bookings are to happen at the tourist park until Christmas. After speaking to a few 'Valla veterans', there is some concern about the tourist park being willing to host this event in the future. Time will only tell and

hopefully next year's event will return as per normal, as this is a great weekend away for many members of the GT community. For quite a lot of members this weekend is their annual holiday and has been for many years. This year just will not be the same for many of those members.

Turning our attention to the events calendar for the rest of 2020, changes have been made to the calendar, so please take the time to have a look at the revised calendar as some events have been moved or dropped altogether. Concours has been moved to Sunday November 15<sup>th</sup>, and our wonderful friends at Penrith Paceway have confirmed this date and are still extremely keen to host this event well into the future as well. The club Christmas Party has had a slight change to the event, with a decision made by the committee to have BYO food and drink, as covid is still raw and on everyone's minds, especially when it comes to food and group servings. Regardless our club has always been extremely diligent with the serving of food at our major events, but for this year we are certain that all members will be more than understanding of the committee's decision.

As the year's end approaches the committee will again meet in late November or early December to discuss and plan ahead for all

events in 2021. Hopefully, we can start off 2021 fresh and get back to enjoying the passion of the Falcon GT together.

On the club membership renewal front, we have had by far the best and quickest renewals on record. Currently we are sitting at 173 members which again shows the strength of the club. Thank you to everyone for getting in your renewals as it has made Andrew's life fairly easy. For those who have renewed you should have received your newly designed membership card in the mail. If you have forgotten to renew as of yet, a friendly reminder that the membership fee is 50% off for this year and the most convenient way to renew is via the PayPal feature on our club's website.

For the next club update, I would like to think that I will be bringing you all some positive news especially on the club events front. 2020, the year to forget.

Until we meet again, please everyone stay safe, healthy, maintain a positive outlook and more importantly check in on your fellow members to make sure that they are getting through this remarkably interesting period of our lives as best as they can.

**11<sup>th</sup> August Update**

Covid-19 has proved highly volatile with varying virus suppression outcomes across the country resulting in varying levels of restrictions including hard state border closures.

Against this backdrop, the Executive Committee of the National Association of Falcon GT Clubs Inc.(NAFGTC) and representatives from the Falcon GT Owners Club of Queensland's 19th GT Nationals Organising Committee (the host club) held a planned review meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2020.

At that meeting the host club advised that **regrettably, due to the current situation of the pandemic in Australia they are unable to hold the event in Easter 2021.**

Following discussion the host club's decision was accepted by the NAFGTC Executive Committee with a view to the host club re-submitting an alternative date for consideration, at a later stage.

Hello fellow members,

I just thought I would provide a little background to the financial reports we have decided to publish in this newsletter. The last financial report published was for the month ending 28<sup>th</sup> February 2020 in the last newsletter. I continue to do the accounting function for the club and generate monthly reports which we keep in our Dropbox folder, so that the whole committee has access to them. Rather than post 6 monthly reports in this newsletter, I have elected to post the one ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020, as this also has the Year to date figures, so you can see how we fared for the last financial year. Likewise, I have posted the August 2020 report, which shows the month of August and the Year to date – the total of July and August 2020.

Every monthly report is available for any member to look at, as well as the detailed transaction cash book which shows every transaction for monies in an out of the club accounts broken down to Bank Account, Paypal and Petty Cash. So, if anyone has trouble sleeping, you can request a copy from me, and I assure you, reading them will instantly cure your insomnia.

Membership renewals are going very well, especially considering that traditionally a lot of renewals are paid in person at a meeting or on a club run, which has obviously not been possible this year. We currently have 173 members, and of those only 43 are still to pay their membership fees. I have processed all the renewals and sent out membership cards to everyone that has renewed. Simply put, if you have not received a membership card from me since the end of July, then I have no record of your renewal – contact me if you have any queries about this. Speaking of which, one member has paid by Bank deposit on 20<sup>th</sup> August using the reference 351351. Could this member please contact me as I have no idea who you are.

Our membership list is available whenever it is updated with renewals, for our Historic Vehicle Registration officer Martin to access. Martin has current information about whether you are a financial member for the purposes of eligibility for the scheme, as per our constitution. If you have a vehicle on the Historic registration scheme with our club, it is imperative that you renew your club membership before 30<sup>th</sup> June each year. If you still have not renewed your membership, I urge you to do so as soon as possible to ensure there are no complications with insurance should the unthinkable happen. Please protect yourselves.

Enough ramblings from me. Let us all hope the Covid risk eases soon, and the current restrictions on gatherings are lifted so that we can meet up at a club run or club meeting.


